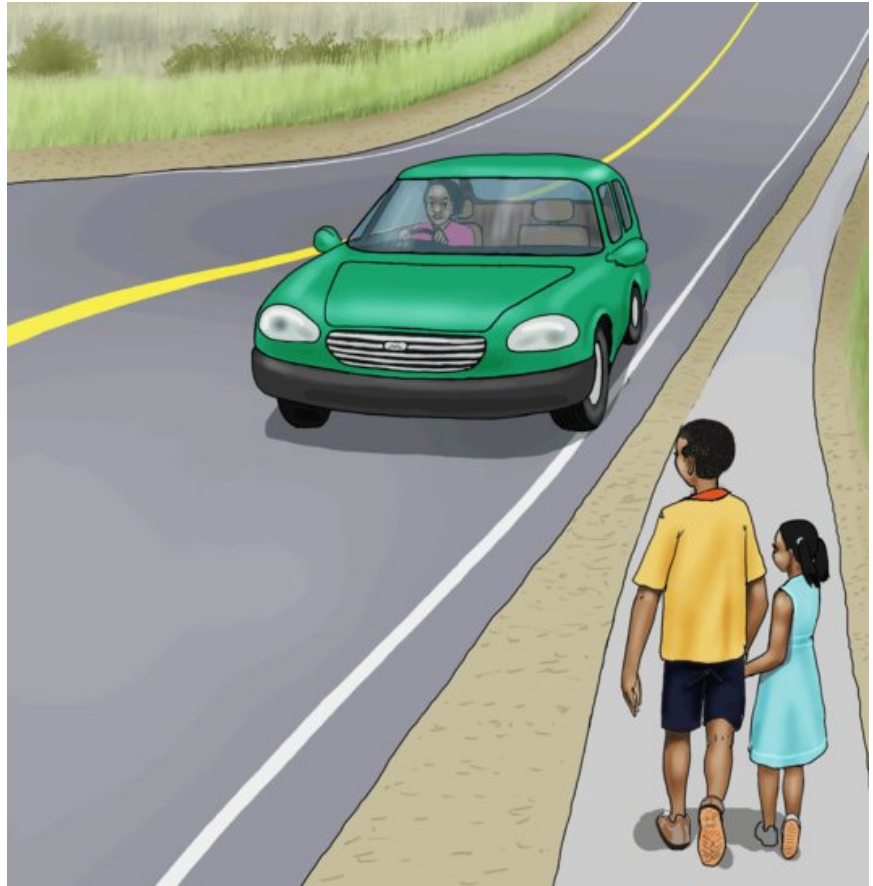
One day my sister and I

A car was speeding up the hill.

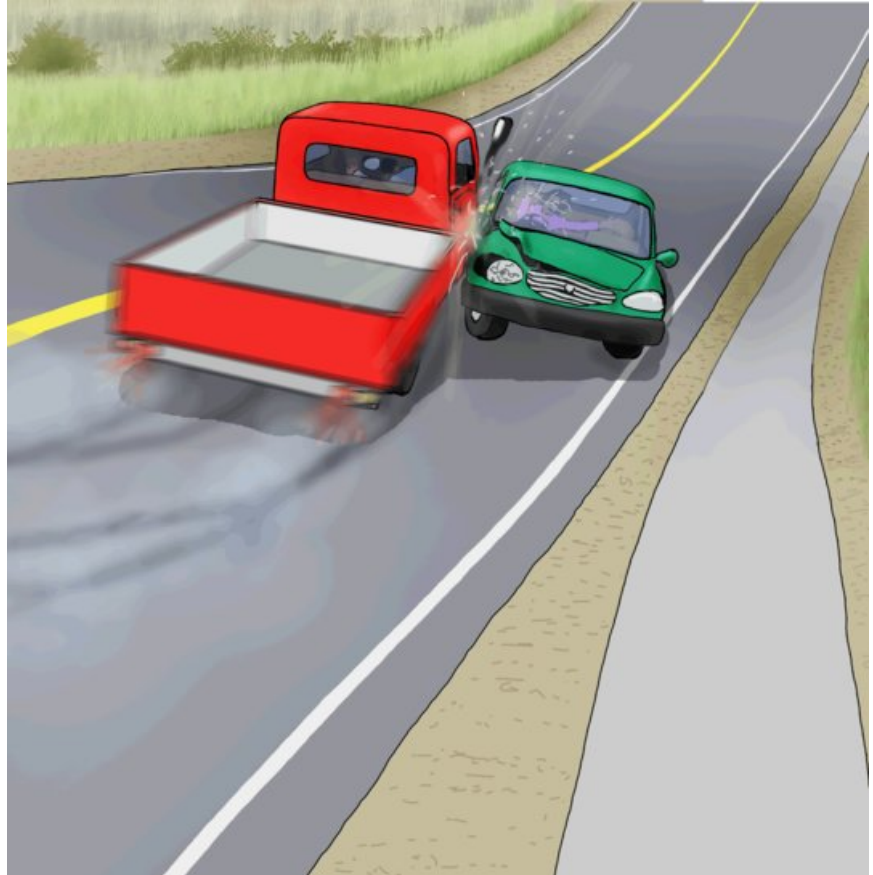




The truck driver was talking on his cell phone.

We saw everything.

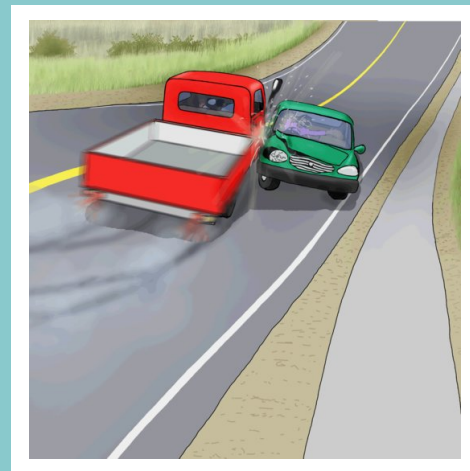
We were shocked.
