He read a good joke.

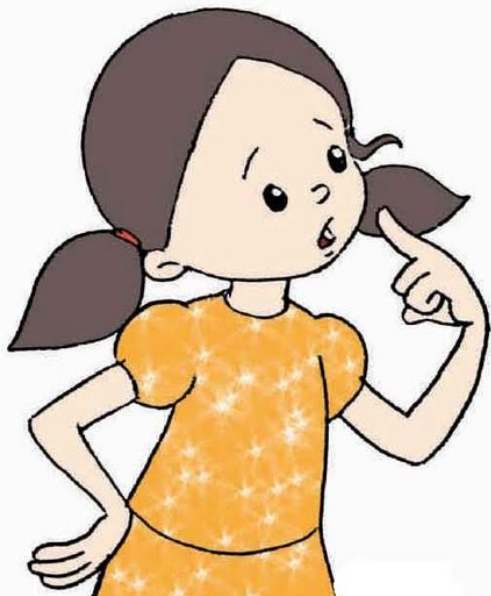




Why is the lady smiling?
