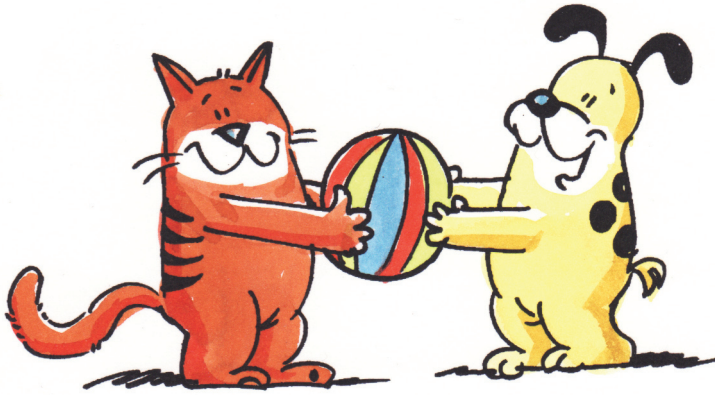

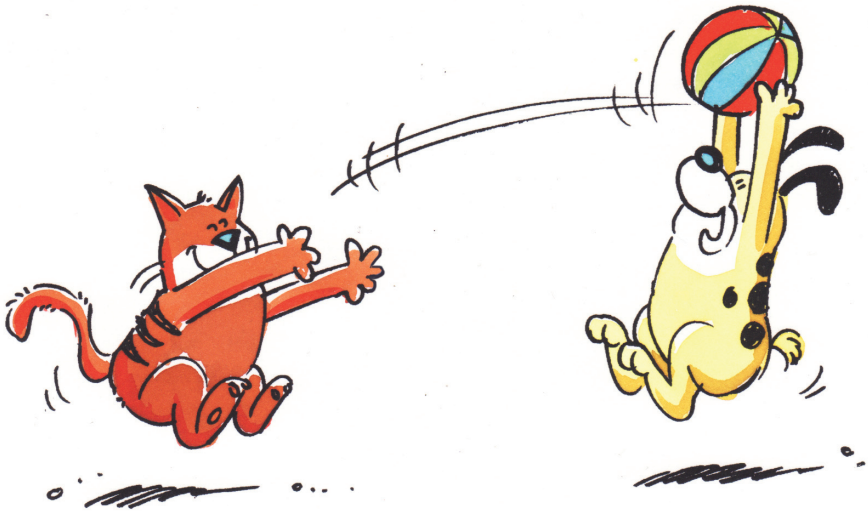
this is dog

then elephant comes by



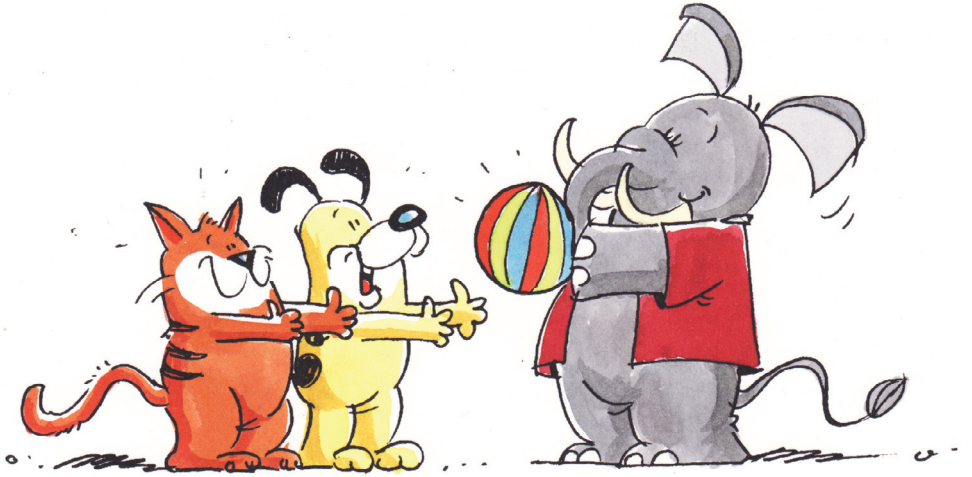
elephant is big

cat catches the ball

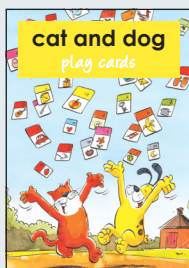
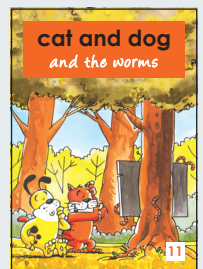
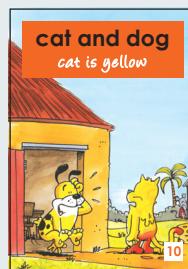
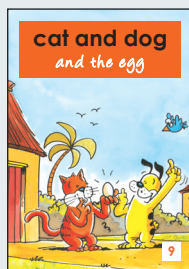
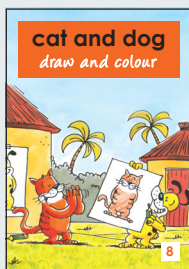
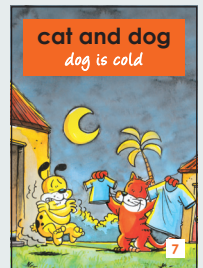
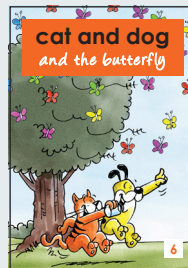
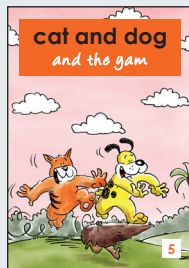
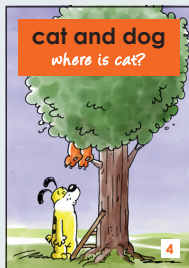
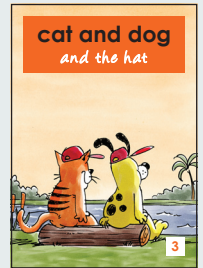
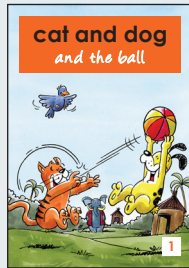
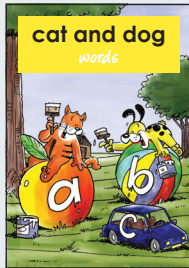
