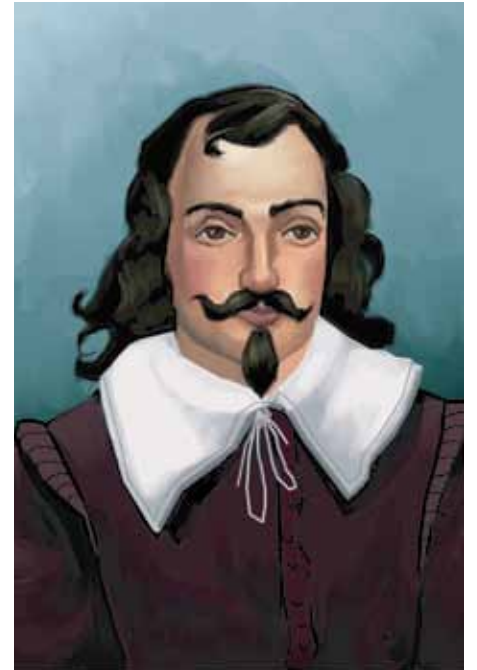
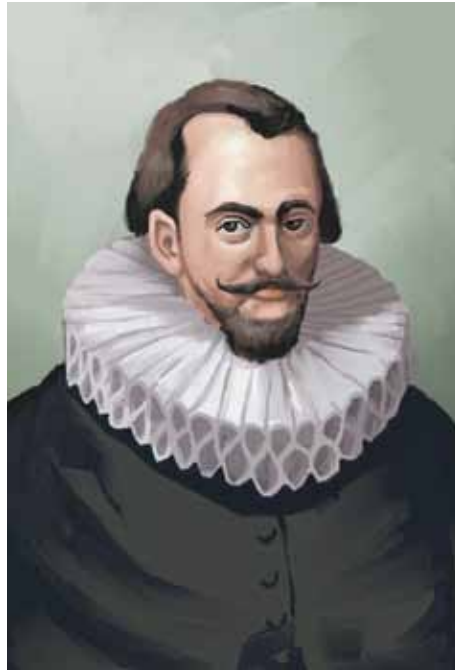


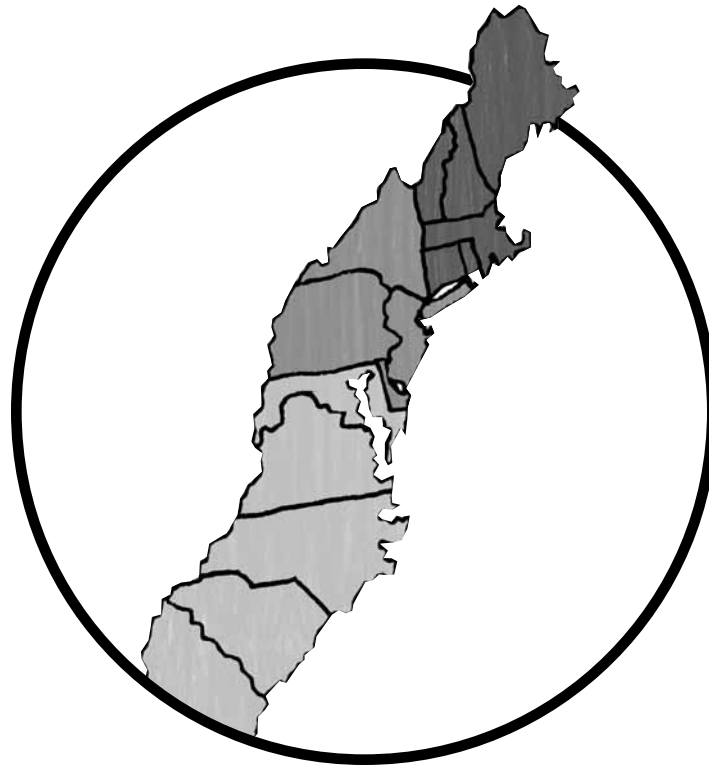


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Card 3 of 25: Viking Explorers



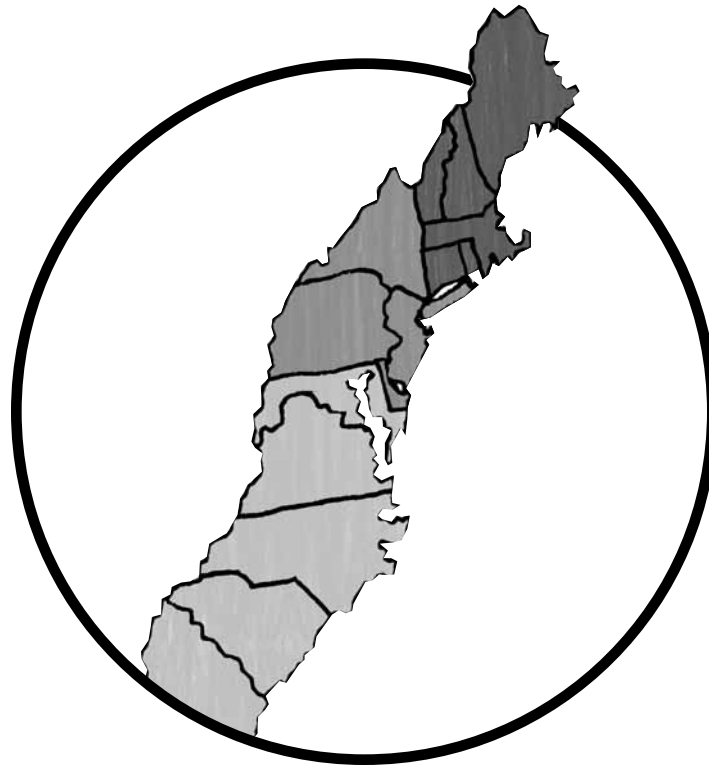


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Card 4 of 25: European Explorers: Columbus, Ponce de León, de Soto, Coronado, Cabot, Hudson, and Champlain



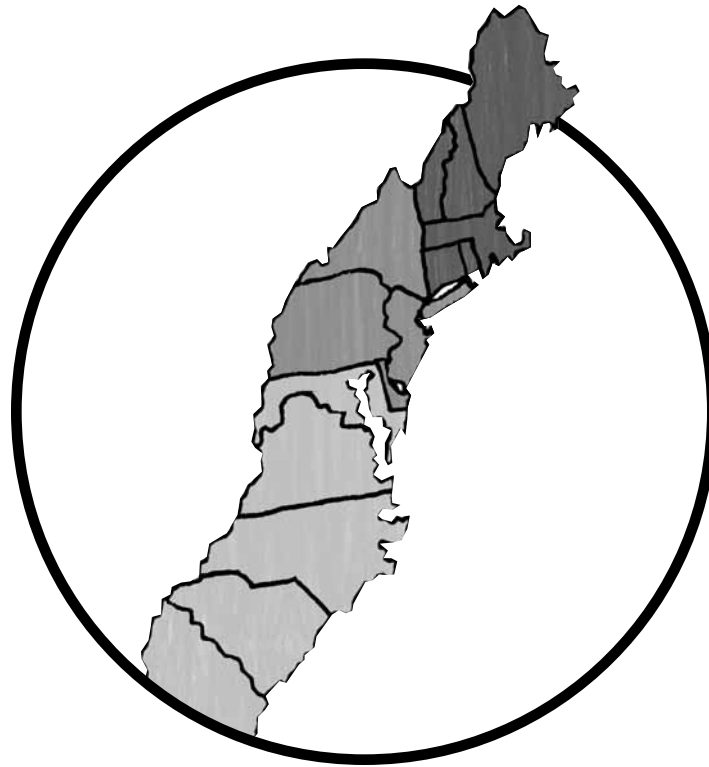


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Card 5 of 25: Roanoke Island Colony

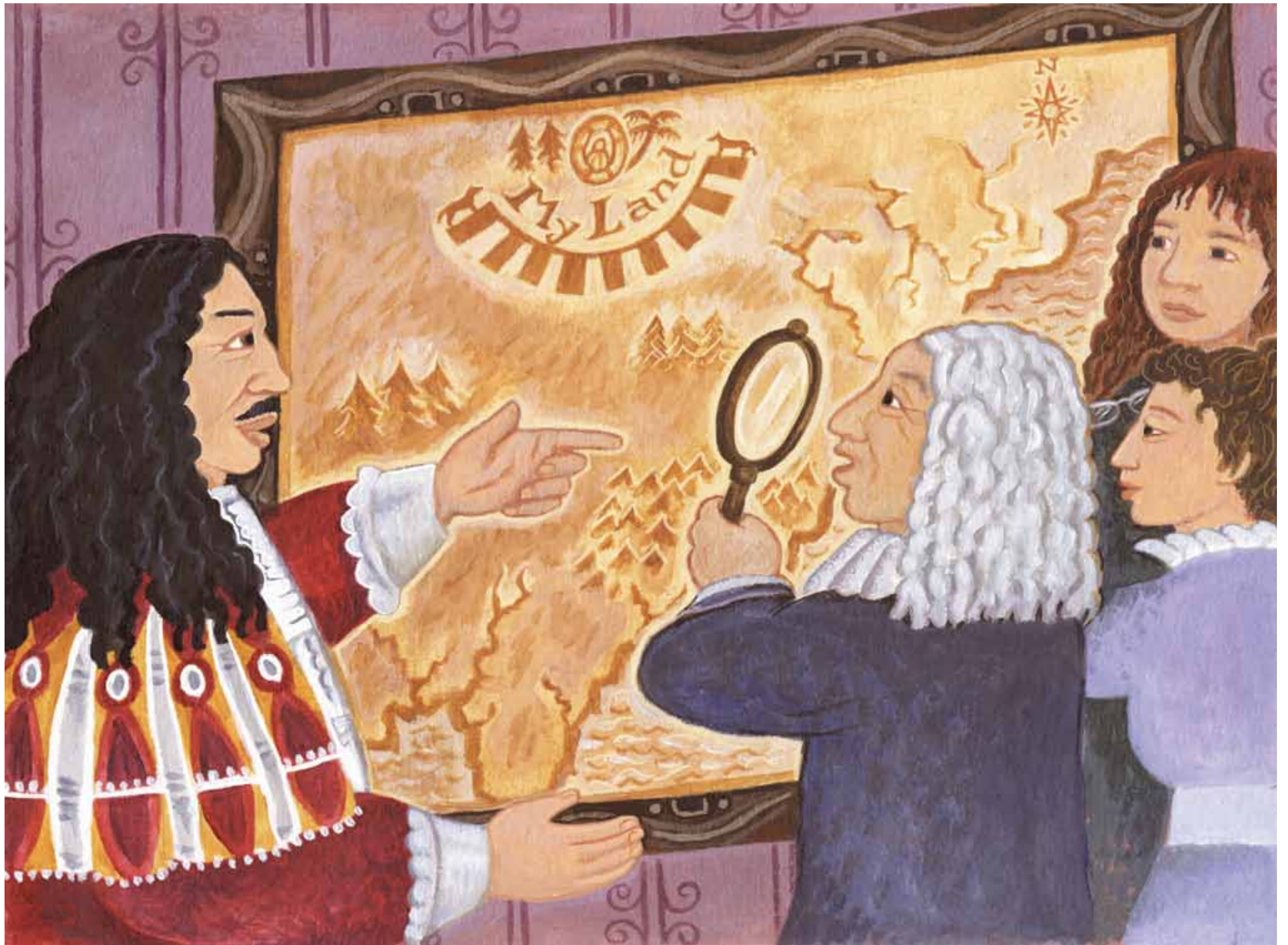


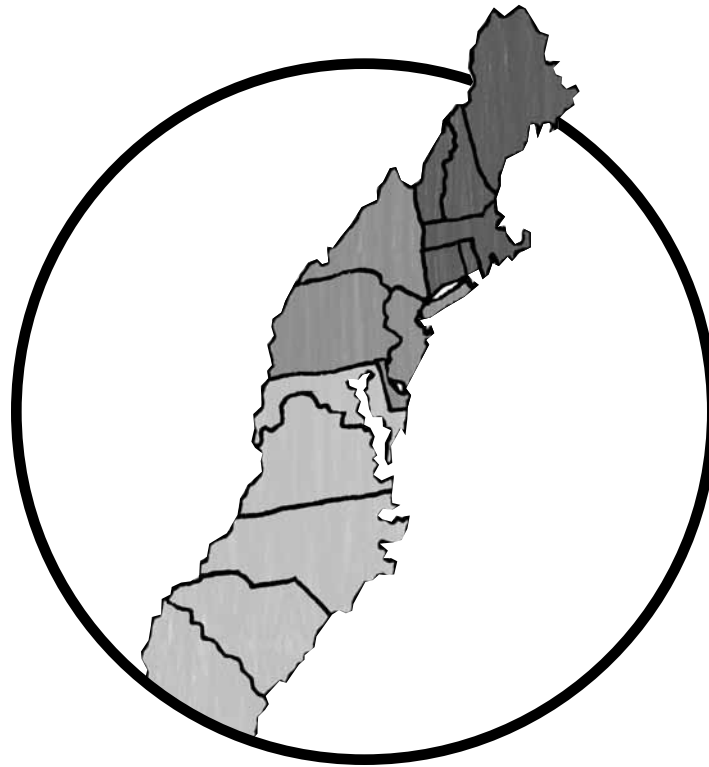


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Card 6 of 25: Jamestown, Virginia: 1607



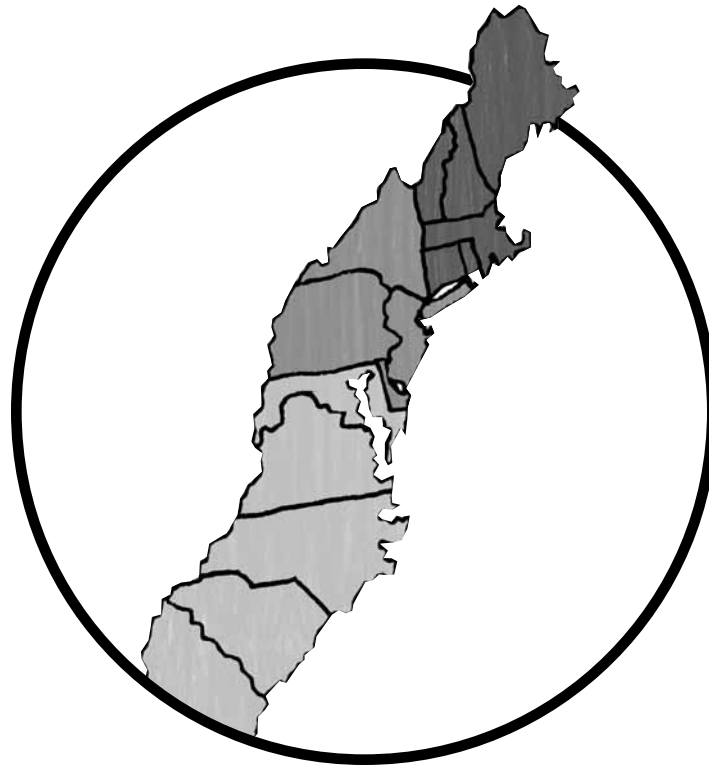


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Card 7 of 25: North and South Carolina



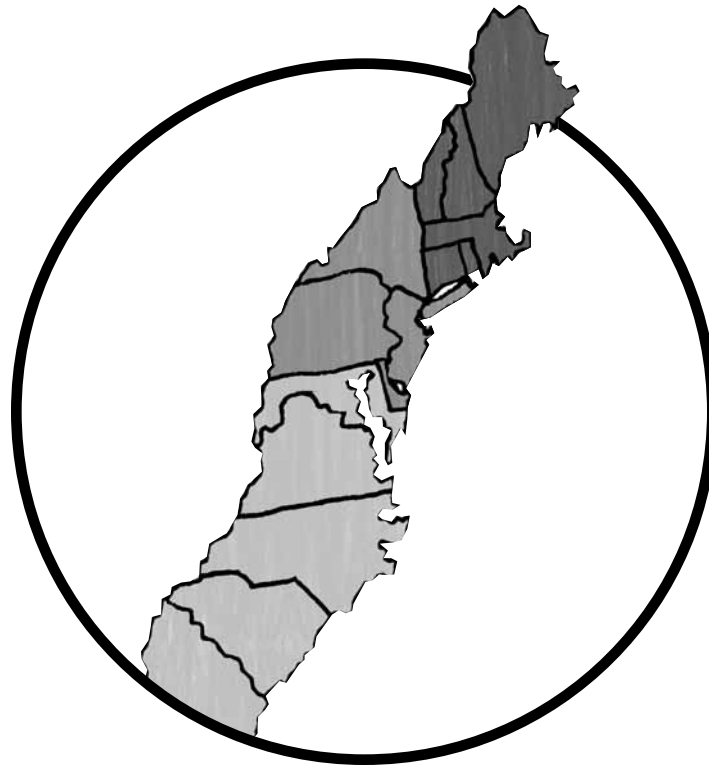


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Card 8 of 25: First-Known African Laborers Brought to the Colonies by Ship: 1619

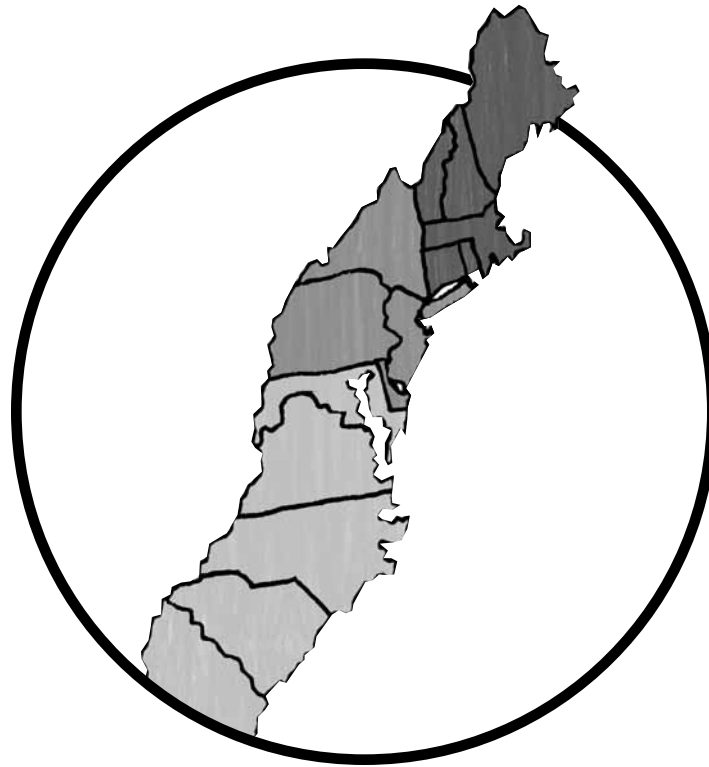

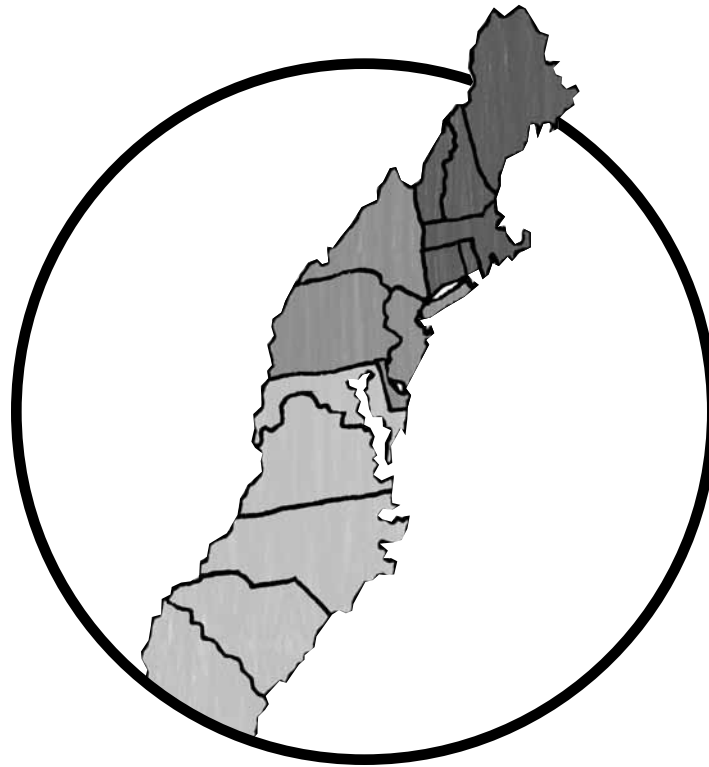

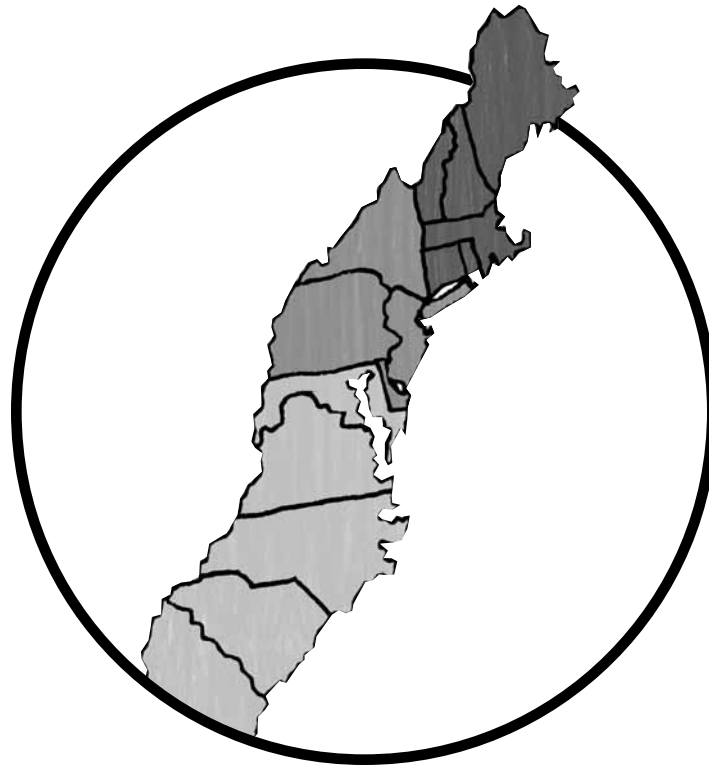


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Card 11 of 25: Plymouth, Massachusetts: 1620



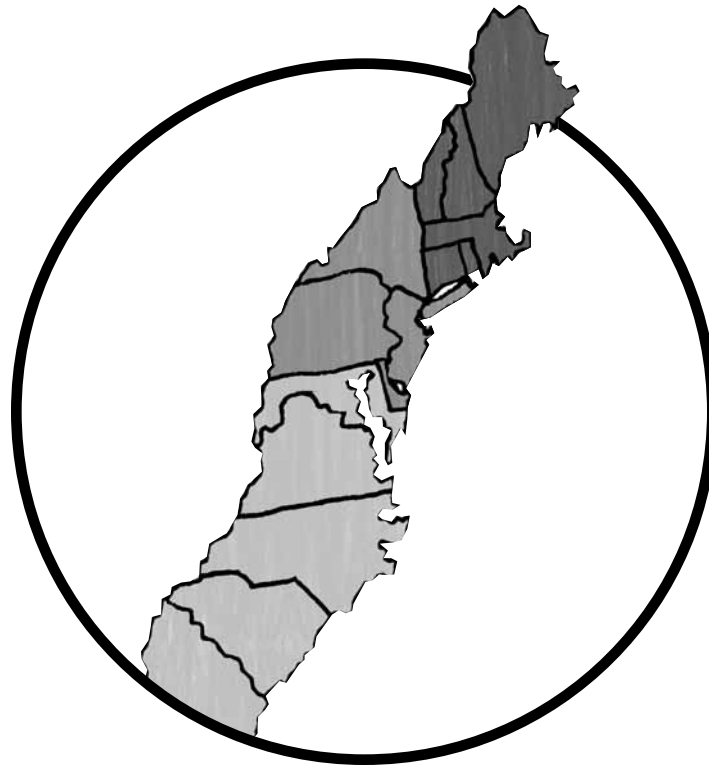


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Card 12 of 25: Massachusetts Bay Colony

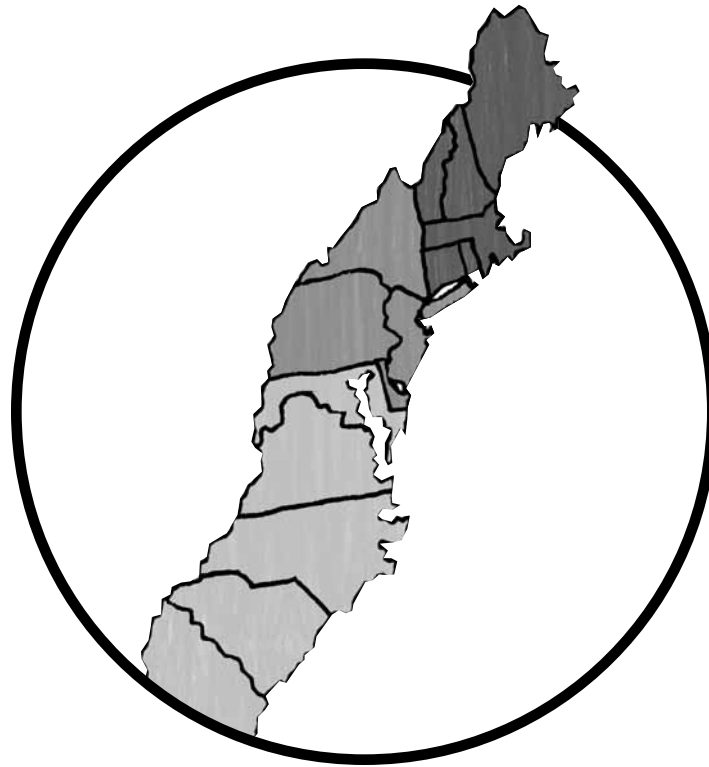

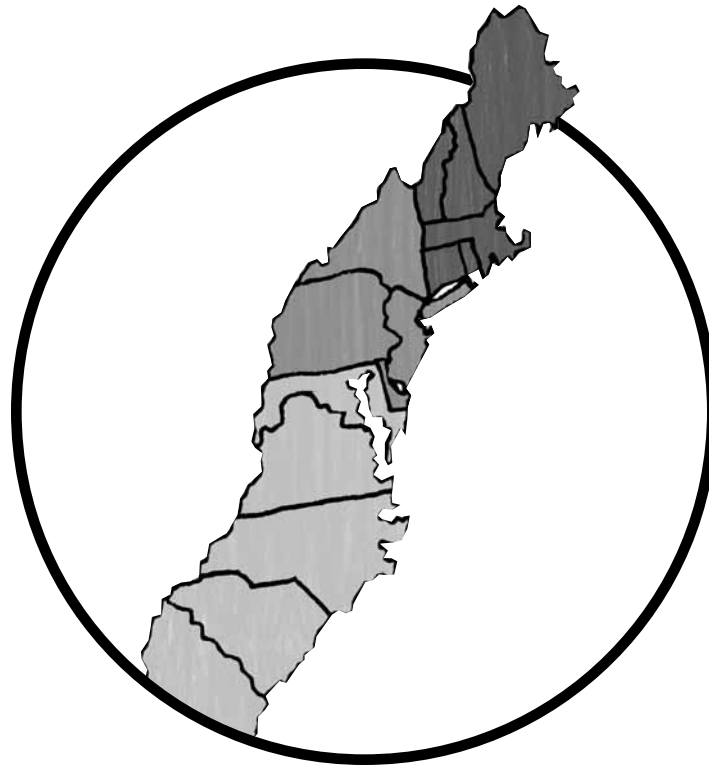

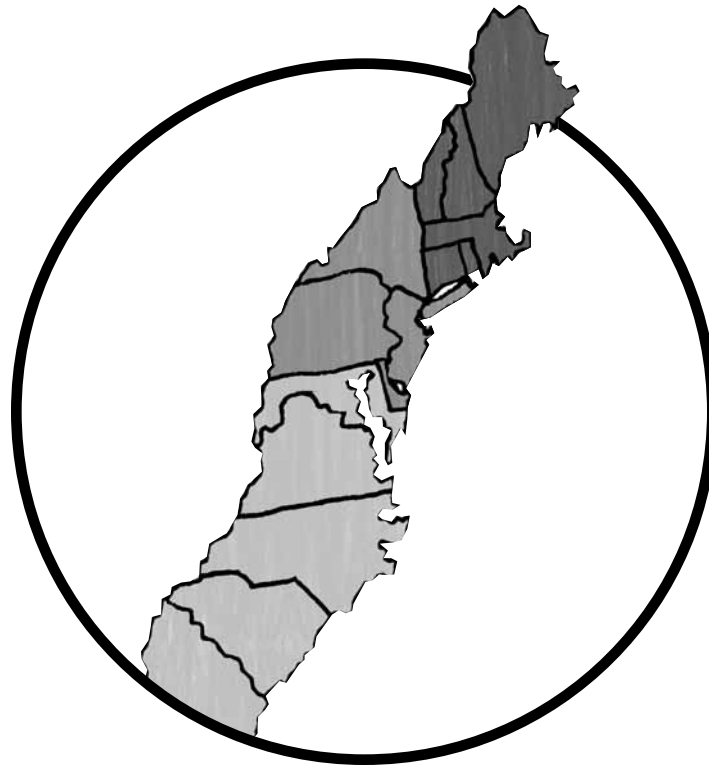


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Card 20 of 25: French and Indian War



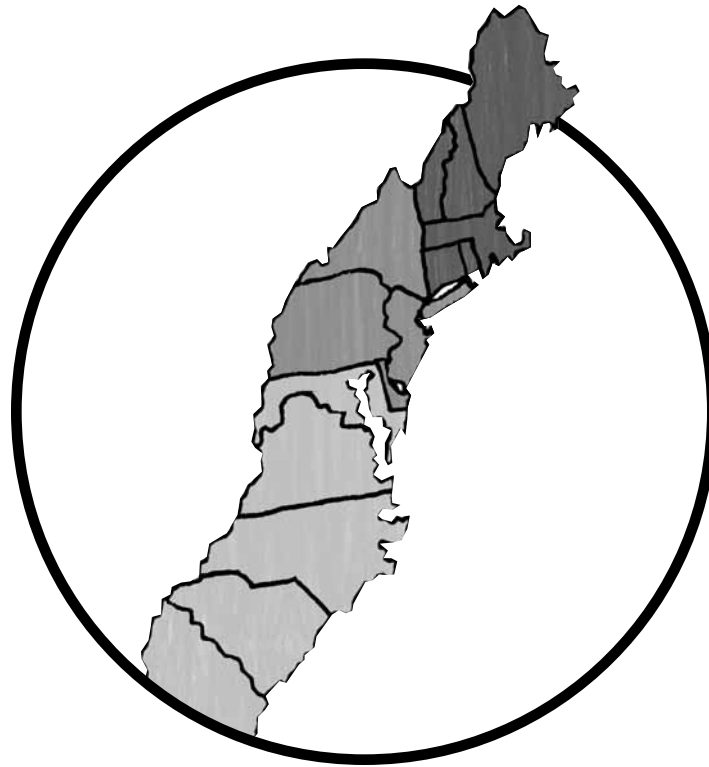


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Card of 21 of 25: Boston Massacre

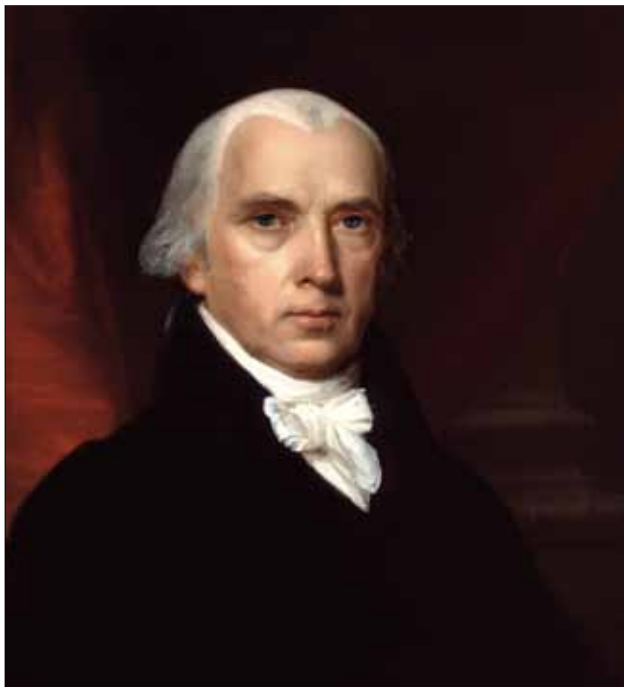
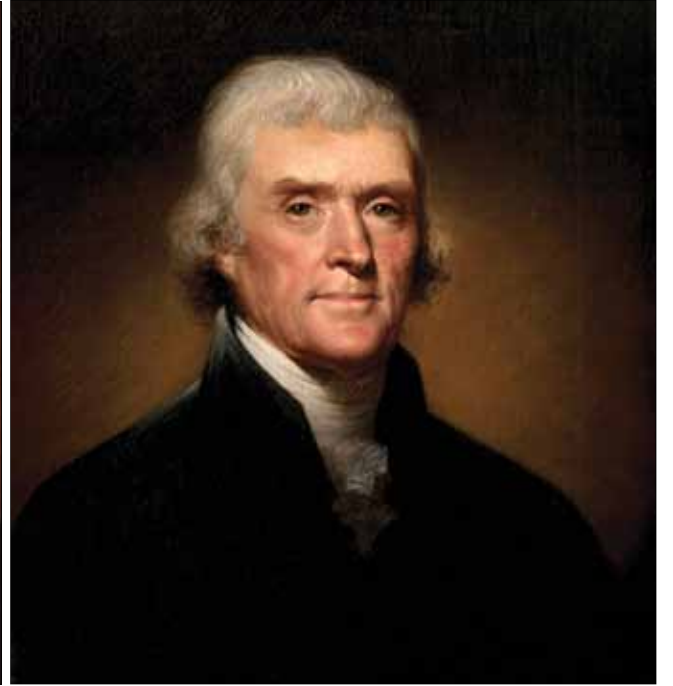


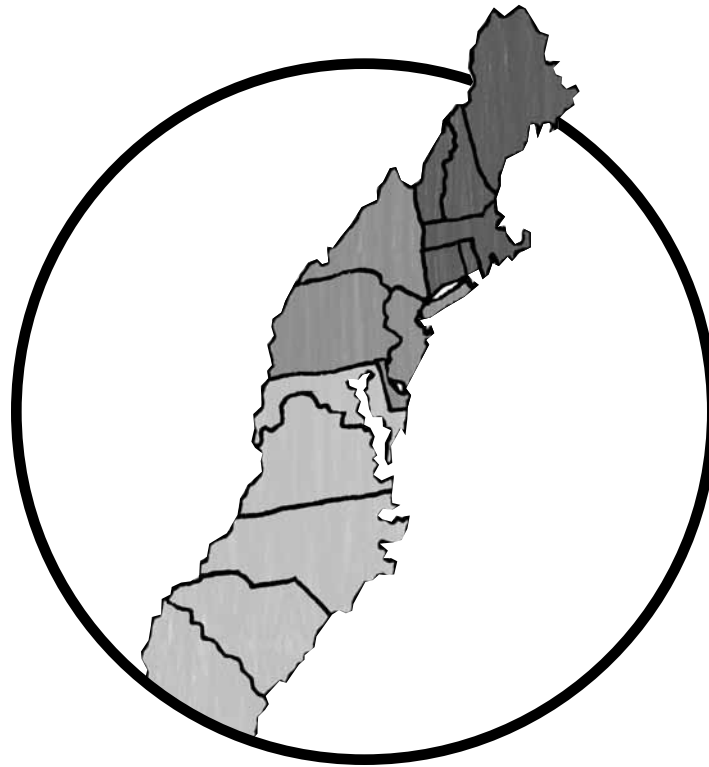


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Card of 22 of 25: Boston Tea Party



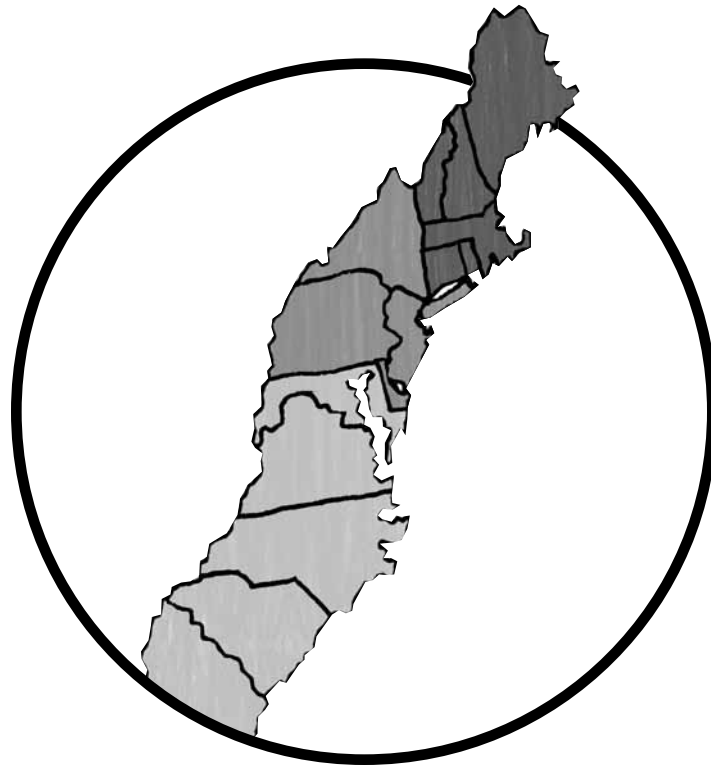

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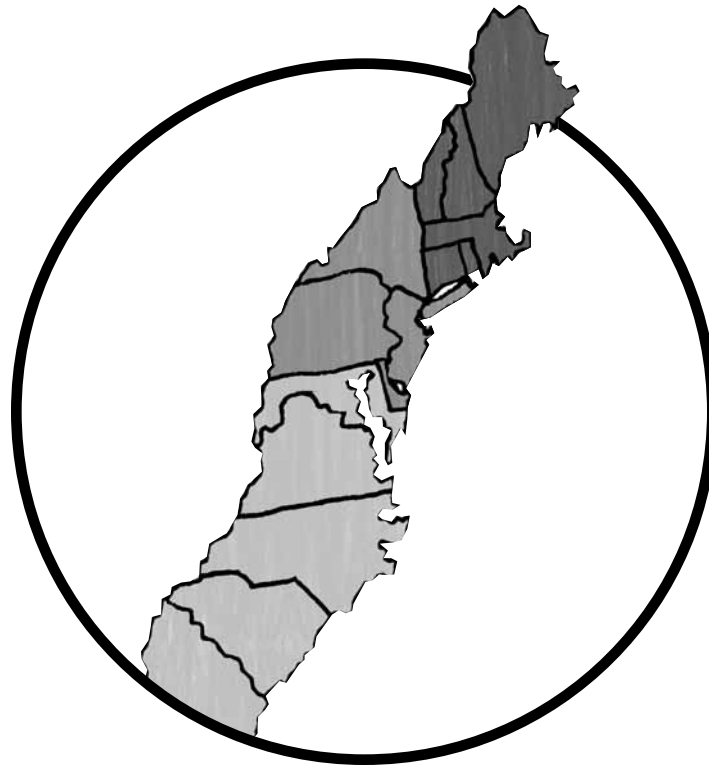

We the People

IN CONGRESS, JULY 4, 1776.

The unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America.

When in the course of human events it becomes necessary for mankind to declare their solemn and irrevocable and unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed. That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such Principles and organizing its Powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to promote their Safety and Happiness. Nor have we ever submitted to a Tyranny which has endeavored to extend its oppressive hand over us, and to abolish the rights which were the birthright of Americans; nor have we suffered ourselves to be quietly led into a more complete and total subjection to a yoke still more oppressive than the former. We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all Men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness. That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed. That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such Principles and organizing its Powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to promote their Safety and Happiness. Nor have we ever submitted to a Tyranny which has endeavored to extend its oppressive hand over us, and to abolish the rights which were the birthright of Americans; nor have we suffered ourselves to be quietly led into a more complete and total subjection to a yoke still more oppressive than the former.
