Cooperative Leadership

- Work with the E! Club leadership to pitch a project idea to Club members.
- Campaign for a leadership position in the E! Club.
- Speak publicly or create a poster for E! Club recruitment.
- Invite one teacher to an E! Club meeting or present a letter to the Associate teacher.

- Facilitate group decision-making in one of your classes or school clubs.

- Lead a team building game during an E! Club meeting, LEC lesson, or with your mentees.
