## CHAPTER 29B — More about Strings

### QUESTION 1:

What does the following code write?

```
class ImmDemo
{
    public static void main ( String[] args )
    {
        String str = new String("I recognize the vestiges of an old flame.");
        str.substring( 16 );
        System.out.println( str );
    }
}
```
