Battles - The Gallipoli Front



This section contains details of the battles and actions fought on the Gallipoli Front during the First World War.

Thus the <u>Entente Powers'</u> initial attempts at storming the Dardanelles solely via naval means alone is documented, as are subsequent attempts at winning control of the region by land means - ultimately without success.

The scope of operations in Gallipoli encompassed a twelve-month period from February 1915 through to the Allied evacuation in December 1915 and January 1916.
