

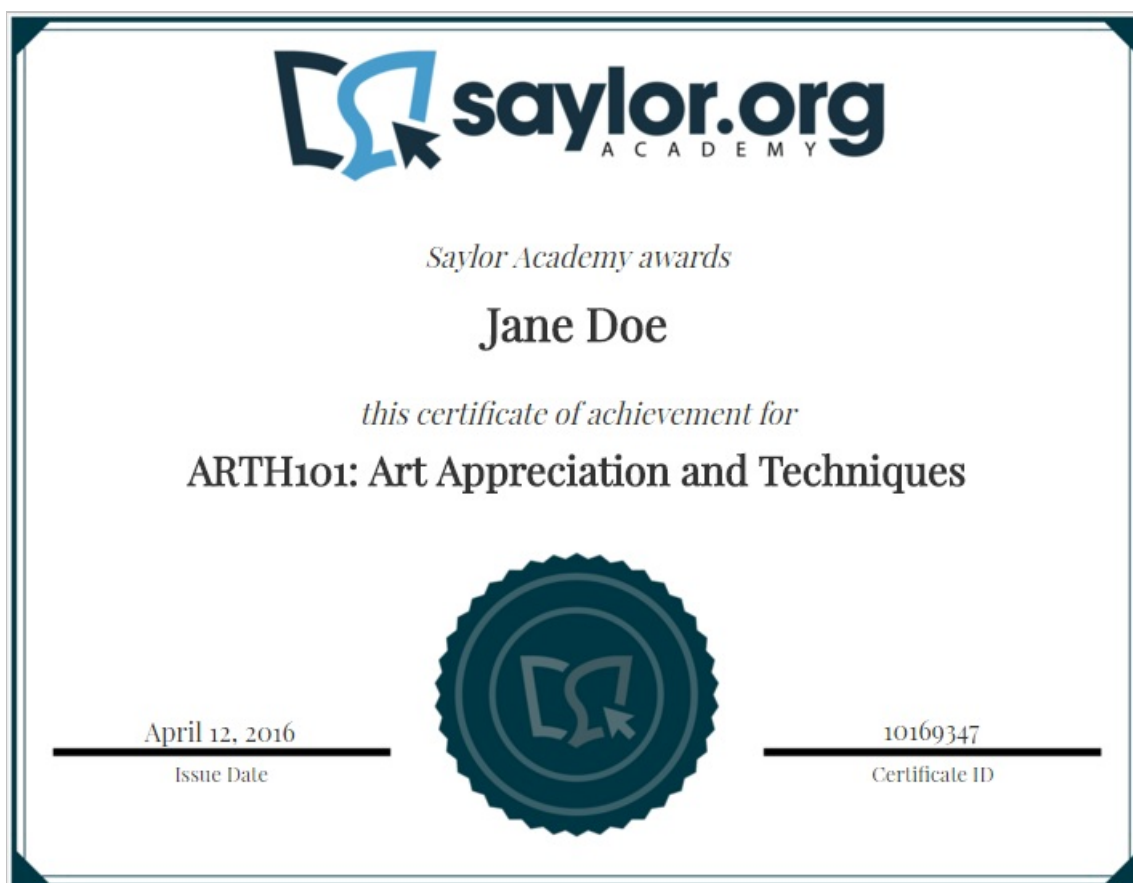

Let people see where you stand – less than 100% simply means that nobody just handed this certificate to you!



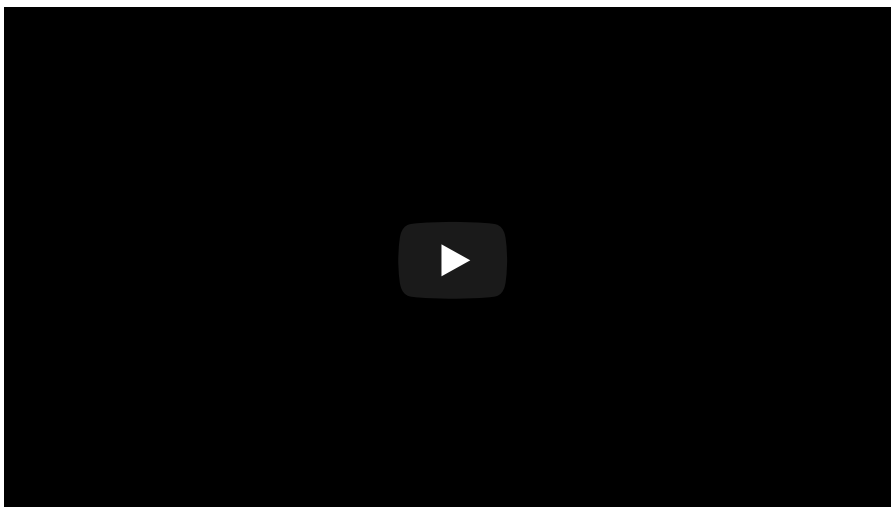
View as part of your Saylor Academy transcript.
