ACE CREDIT® connects workplace learning with colleges and universities by helping students gain access to academic credit for formal training taken outside traditional degree programs.

With over 35,000 programs reviewed, CREDIT is the national leader in the evaluation process for non-accredited courses, workplace training, exams, apprenticeships, and other types of nontraditional forms of education.

In 2015, ACE launched the **Alternative Credit Project™**, an ecosystem of over 50 colleges and universities that guaranteed acceptance of low- or no-cost, online general education courses for direct transfer credit towards a learner's degree. The project brought together six course providers and over 100 courses with **ACE credit recommendations valid from April 1, 2015 through May 31, 2018.**
