

# Key facts about pupil learning, teaching and school management in **Kailahun District**



# Fact 1

In Kailahun, learning levels of JSS2 and SSS2 pupils are low in both English and Mathematics.






Learning levels in Kailahun are lower than the national average


Fact 2

In Kailahun, learning levels of JSS2 girls and boys are similar, but SSS2 girls score lower than SSS2 boys.




# Fact 3

JSS2 pupils from wealthier households perform better in English than JSS pupils from poorer households, in Kailahun.

In Kailahun, a small percentage of JSS and SSS teachers are female. Teacher characteristics in Kailahun are similar to the national average statistics.

Fact 7

92% of JSS teachers now use printed MBSSE lesson plans in Kailahun. However, 57% of these teachers find it difficult to link learning objectives to the appropriate grade level



9 in every 10 JSS teachers use printed MBSSE lesson plans in Kailahun 6 out of 10 JSS teachers that use lesson plans in Kailahun are unable to link learning objectives

to the appropriate

grade level



In Kailahun, a similar fraction of teachers make the right links, as at the national level, where only 4 in 10 teachers are able to do so

# Fact 6

A typical JSS school in Kailahun has 28 pupils per teacher. The pupil-teacher ratio is lower in SSS schools.

JSS pupil teacher ratio




SSS pupil teacher ratio

The percentage of **lesson observations** in **Kailahun** compare **very similarly** to the **national average**. However, **PTR ratios** are comparatively **higher** in **Kailahun**.

# Fact 8

All schools in Kailahun have parent-teacher or community-teacher associations. Most of these bodies are active, having met at-least once in the current or previous term.
